Dear Parents / Carers,

I am sure that you are keeping up to date with all the news regarding COVID-19 and will be aware of the Government's announcements.

We respectfully remind you of the following:

The main symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are:

- A high temperature, this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you have noticed that you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child has any of these symptoms, please do not send your son into school and get a PCR test (test that is sent to a lab) to check if they have coronavirus and stay at home until they get their result, even if the symptoms are mild.

There are also other symptoms to look out for which are:

- Sore throat
- Headache
- Runny nose.

If your child has any of these symptoms, please do not send you child into school and please get a PCR test.

If the above symptoms are mild, please still follow this guidance.

If your child does come into school with any of the above symptoms, the school will contact you to come and collect, and you will need to arrange for a PCR test.

This advice has been received from the COVID Response Co-ordinator for Public Health.
