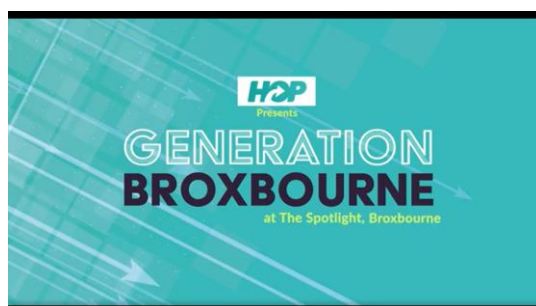


Year 10 visit to
