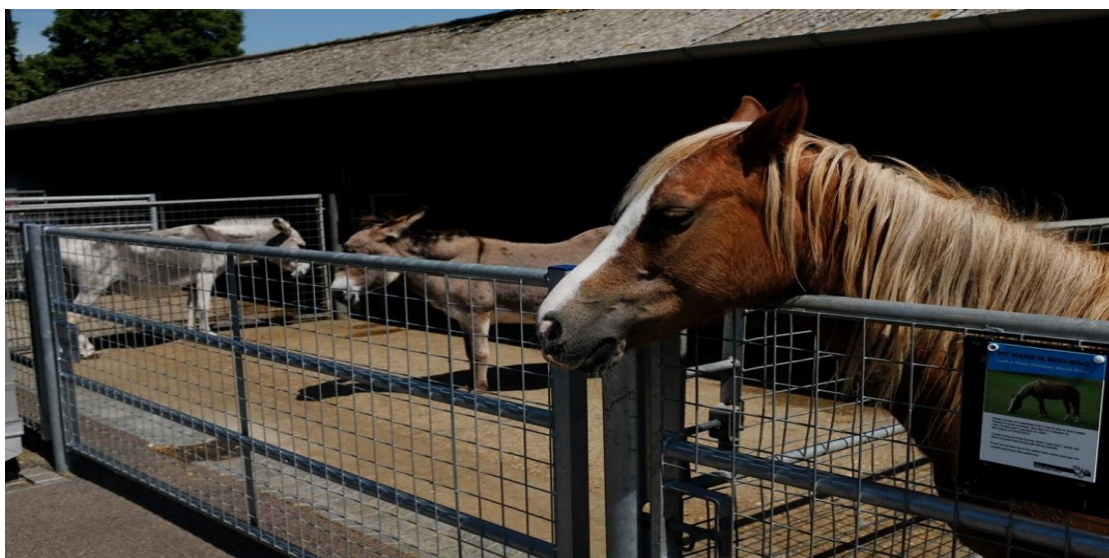


Harlow Petting Zoo

Pets' Corner



Opened in 1966, Pets' Corner is a small, friendly farm located in Harlow Town Park. It has a large selection of traditional farm animals, such as rabbits, chickens and ducks, more exotic animals such as reindeer, llamas and alpacas, as well as a number of [rare breeds](#) including Middle White and Tamworth pigs.

Opening times

Open 7 days a week from 11am to 4.30pm.

Pets' Corner is closed on Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

Admission

Pets' Corner is free to enter, but welcomes donations in the box on site.

Pets' Corner does not have its own car park. The nearest council car park is a 3-minute walk away in [School Lane](#).

Pets Corner is a 10-minute walk from Harlow Town train station.

Accreditations-

Land Based Studies is a certificated educational course run in partnership with Writtle College.

The course is a 1 or 2 year course delivered 1 day per week on a Wednesday or Thursday at Pets' Corner targeted at 14 to 16 year olds. Participants will be working closely with all the animals at Pets' Corner including mucking out, feeding, grooming, providing enrichment as well as other animal welfare tasks.

The course is mainly practical based so it's working with the animals in an informal setting along with some classroom studies as you work towards a Level 1 City and Guilds qualification.
