Dear Parent/Carer,

From our recent coffee morning with the Headteacher and Chair of Trustees, we received valuable feedback on our Yr. 9 options process that we would like to respond to.

Many of you felt that our identified date for options happened too late into the academic year. That the original date allowed you little time to consider the available options and time to work with your son and subject teachers in supporting your son's emerging interests in his curriculum pathways.

Responding to your feedback we are in a position to move forward this date from the end of the Spring term to **Wednesday 11th January 2023**.

This will enable you to have a full overview of the potential pathways of our KS4 core and options subjects prior to the Learning Review Evening on **Wednesday 18th January 2023**.

Additionally, looking at next academic year, we intend to move the Options Evening permanently to occur in October where it also will fall before the Learning Consultation Evening.

During the options evening, you and your son can find out the various subjects and pathways that are available and consider which are appropriate for him, as he moves into Key Stage 4.
