



## Examinations Headlines



Hailey Hall’s achievement is very good, when compared and contextualised with national data. This is due to quality of teaching learning in the school. We provide excellent interventions as and when identified by the team, as being necessary to support individuals in their progress and achievement.

- The average attainment 8 score for our pupils was 17.1 points **COMPARED TO 2024 DATA, WHICH WAS 3.8 NATIONALLY FOR OTHER SPECIAL SCHOOL PUPILS IN 2024.**
- The Attainment 8 figure using the average of subjects that pupils study at our school and not all on the Attainment 8 official list is 21.15
- There is no Progress 8 in 2025. These pupils did not take Key Stage 2 due to covid. Progress was calculated comparing the targets against the actual outcomes.
- In 2025 6% of pupils achieved a GCSE 4 or above grades in both English and Mathematics **COMPARED TO 2.8% FOR OTHER SPECIAL SCHOOL PUPILS NATIONALLY IN 2024.**





Each pupil has been set target grades. Each grade has then been shown in the table above against the outcome. Of the 27 grades that were targeted to be a 4 or above 51% achieved that benchmark or above. Overall 65% of grades were on target or above.



## 5 Year Trend




- The average Attainment 8 score for our pupils in 2025 was 17.1 points **COMPARED TO 17.67 POINTS IN 2024.**
- In 2025 6% of pupils achieved 4 or above grades in both English and Mathematics **COMPARED TO 14% IN 2024.**
- 6% of pupils achieved 5 or above grades in both English and Mathematics **COMPARED TO 9% IN 2024**
- No progress 8 score for 2025 due to there being no KS2 data for this cohort, due to Covid 19.

## Vulnerable Groups



Hailey Hall supports disadvantaged pupils by providing additional intervention and support.

- The Attainment 8 score for our disadvantaged pupils is 15.7 **COMPARED TO 2.9 POINTS NATIONALLY IN 2024 DFE CALCULATION.**
- Despite there being no official Progress 8 data, the Progress shown on the graph above and table below is the difference between the average target and average grade the pupils achieved. -0.46 is about half a grade lower. It is not progress 8, it is a comparison between the targets the school set based on their attainment at the school against the average they actually achieved.



The table above and graph below show the grade distribution (raw number of pupils) for our GCSE qualifications.



The table below shows the grade distribution for all vocational qualifications. It is very encouraging to see all pupils achieving at least a level 2 pass in craft, food and cookery and employability. Achievements in science are also excellent with all but 3 pupils achieving at least a level 2 pass. It is worth noting also the level 2 qualifications achieved in English and maths, which are equivalent to a GCSE 4.
